 - NordREG work on CEP will be a vital part of NordREG work program 2020
- First result of the common CEP work has just been published



Coordinated implementation of EU-legislation

- November 19th, NordREG published 21 Nordic recommendations on how to implement retail related articles in the new Electricity Directive
- Two important road choices:
 - Termination fees
 - Comparison tools
- Many common interpretations of individual provisions:
 - Key contractual conditions
 - Let customers choose channel for information
 - Bills and billing information free of charge
 - Mandatory information in bills



NordREG will do more 2020

- NordREG will look at remaining gaps and asymmetries
 - Commissions Barriers to entry report
 - Follow implementation of new EU-legislation
 - Evaluate benefits of further harmonization
- It's difficult to compromise
 - We all used time and resources to make our markets work in a certain way
 - Easier to keep status quo than to change
 - Hard to value benefits of harmonization against cost for compromises
